2. Jer 17:9 - The heart of man is deceitful and desperately wicked. Rom 3:23 - all have sinned.
3. All born body, soul, and spirit. In Genesis, God breathed life into dust. A living soul and spirit were placed into Adam and his body came to life. Soul = mind, will and emotions. Spirit = eternal, also described as the heart of a person. Sin enters the world and death with it. Relationship destroyed.

5. New creatures in Christ Jesus, old things have passed away. Behold all things become new. 2 Cor 5:17

8. Desire to allow Holy Spirit to reveal everything in our lives that hinders love and deal with it. Phil 2:13
9. God is love. Pure love. How does He love? - Unconditionally. Without reservation. With no limits.

11. If I know your heart God, I will not believe Satan's lies. I will be able to tell the difference between truth and the lie.
12. Maybe you are going through hard times. Maybe the view looks grand from your mountain top experience. Either way, He is with you.
13. God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. He is good all the time. Righteousness and justice form the foundation of His throne. He is faithful and true. He is trustworthy. Pure, holy, and without stain, blemish, or reproach. He is the ultimate promise keeper. The same yesterday, today, and forever. The

first and the last. Alpha and Omega. Beginning and the end. *Let's take a moment to reflect on His character, who He is, and how He has revealed himself to us individually.*
