A. Clear, Persuasive, and Faithful

1. Be Clear

- Relationship with Jesus is the ANSWER
- If you don't know, say so. I.e. “I have never thought about this, I want to know what you believe and why you believe it. Let me think about it”

2. Create desire for what you have

3. Faithful to the Word

- I live faithful, I communicate faithfully.
- Solve the first problem first.
- Trust God to do His part

B. Seize the opportunities.

- Make the most of opportunity
- Create opportunities
- You don't know if you are their last opportunity.

II.  + **N** 

A. Colossians 4:5-6 (NIV) *“Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone.”*

1. People like nice people
2. Being nice is persuasive
3. Being nice is expected

B. 1 Peter 3: 5-16 *“Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a*

gentle and respectful way. Keep your conscience clear. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ."

- C. 2 Tim 2:24 "A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone, be able to teach, and be patient with difficult people."
