

ADVANCED PROPHETIC TRAINING - MODULE ONE
"MINISTERING SPIRITUAL GIFTS" Scripture Memorization

It is recommended that you start memorizing these verses prior to the first class. All verses below, and in the workbook, are in the New King James Version. You may choose to memorize your verses in a different version, but please specify which one you are using.

Lesson #1: 1 Corinthians 12:7 (*Must be memorized prior to first class*)

"But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:"

Lesson #2: Hebrews 5:14

"But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

Lesson #3: 1 Timothy 1:18

"This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare,"

Lesson #4: II Timothy 1:6

"Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands."

Lesson #5: 1 Peter 4:10

"As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."

Lesson #6: 1 Corinthians 14:39-40

"Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues. Let all things be done decently and in order."

Lesson #7: Romans 12:6

"Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, *let us use them*: if prophecy, *let us prophesy* in proportion to our faith;"

Lesson #8: 1 Corinthians 14:31

"For you can all prophesy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged."

Lesson #9: Psalm 22:3

"But You *are* holy, Enthroned in the praises of Israel."

Lesson #10: Colossians 3:16

“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”

FOR THOSE NEEDING A LITTLE HELP WITH MEMORY VERSES

USE THE 5x5 SCRIPTURE MEMORIZATION METHOD:

- While looking at the verse, read it out loud 5 times
- While looking at the verse, read it silently to yourself (in your head) 5 times
- Without looking at the verse, say it silently to yourself (in your head) 5 times
- Without looking at the verse, say it out loud 5 times
- Without looking at the verse, write it out 5 times

OTHER HELPFUL HINTS

1. Break the verse into manageable parts in order to better understand it.
2. Apply the verse to the current lesson then to yourself. If there is a name in it such as: “Son Timothy”, put your name in its place.
3. READ IT - WRITE IT - SING IT - SAY IT - PRAY IT!
4. RELAX; stress blocks your memory. Take a deep breath and breathe...really, it helps.

WHEN RECITING A SCRIPTURE

- DO NOT learn by rote only. Put some feeling into your words, even be a littledramatic. Look into a mirror if by yourself, or make eye contact if to another, This engages your mind, body and spirit.
- Smile... smiling helps build your confidence and also makes everyone else around you happy too!
